

### ▲ WARNING

#### SERVICING OF DOUBLE-INSULATED WET/DRY VAC

In a double-insulated Wet/Dry Vac, two systems of insulation are provided instead of earthing. No earthing is provided on a double-insulated appliance, nor should a means for earthing be added. Servicing a double-insulated Wet/Dry Vac requires extreme care and knowledge of the system, and should be done only by qualified service personnel. Replacement parts for a double-insulated Wet/Dry Vac must be identical to the parts they replace. Your double-insulated Wet/Dry Vac is marked with the words "DOUBLE INSULATED" and the symbol  (square within a square) may also be marked on the appliance.

To reduce the risk of injury from electrical shock, unplug the power cord before servicing the electrical parts of the Wet/Dry Vac.
